

Wood Duck House Plans

Materials Needed:

- 1 1" x 12" x 10' white cedar board
- 2 20 2" deck screws
- 3 2 square bend hooks
- 4 4" by 16" utility wire strip
- 5 staples and staple gun to attach above

Assembly Instructions:

First screw sides to back, then attach bottom. Staple utility wire on inside of front board from the bottom up to the entry hole so ducklings can climb it when ready. Now attach the front with only one screw on each side about 2" from top of front. This creates a hinge so that you can easily open the front. There should be about 1/4" gap between the roof and top of front for ventilation. The door is held closed with square end hooks screwed into the face of the sides towards the bottom. Next attach the roof and your done. After hanging on tree fill with about 11lb of nesting material such as pine or cedar bedding.
